

WINDOWS 7 64BIT INSTALLATION

Windows 7 User Account Control should be set to Notify Me Only When....

ALL STEPS MUST BE FOLLOWED

1. Insert the UL Fire CD
Choose Open Folder to View Files; OR; if necessary, cancel the Autorun, go to Computer, right click on the cd, and choose Open
2. On the cd locate the setup.exe application (32-bit Setup Launcher), right click, and choose Properties
3. In Properties select the Compatibility tab:
 - Put a check in “Run this program in compatibility mode for: Windows XP (Service Pack 3):
 - Put a check in “Run this program as an administrator”
(If this is grayed out, it may be necessary to check the Windows 7 User Account Control settings)
 - Click Apply and OK; you should be returned to the cd file list
4. Right click on Setup.exe and choose “Run as administrator”
5. During the installation:
Welcome Screen, click Next
Choose Destination Location Screen – Follow these instructions:
 - Click the Browse button
 - In the Directories box, select c:\users\<(choose your user name)
 - In the Path box, add \ULFireCD after your user name
 - Click OK; choose Yes to create new folder
 - You should be returned to the Choose Destination Location Menu
 - Click Next
 - Follow the rest of the defaults
6. After the installation is complete, click Finish.
7. At this time, close all windows that were opened during the installation process
8. Go to the Desktop, find the UL Fire CD Shortcut, right-click and choose Properties
9. In Properties select the Compatibility tab:
 - Put a check in “Run this program in compatibility mode for: Windows XP (Service Pack 3):
 - Put a check in “Run this program as an administrator”
 - Click on “Change setting for all users”
 - Put a check in “Run this program in compatibility mode for: Windows XP (Service Pack 3):
 - Put a check in “Run this program as an administrator”
 - Click Apply and OK
 - Again, Click Apply and OK on the UL Fire CD Screen (you may have to provide Administrative Privileges, click continue, then OK).
10. Go to Desktop and click on the UL Fire CD shortcut.
